

MTTI Student Policies re: COVID-19

Update: 11/6/2023

To ensure the health and safety of all students and staff at MTTI, all students and staff must follow the following procedures & precautions:

- 1) Masks are not required, but students or staff may opt to wear a mask if they chose to do so.
 - a. Any individuals who harass or bully other students for opting to wear a mask will be subject to disciplinary action – this type of behavior will not be tolerated.
 - b. Masks must be worn by individuals who are observing COVID-19 precautions following a positive COVID test or exposure. That timeline will be determined by the Department of Health.
- 2) Any staff or students who that are sick or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent home immediately. If you are feeling sick you should stay home and contact your instructor why you are out.
- 3) Students must immediately notify MTTI if they have tested positive for COVID-19 or have recently been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
 - a. Students who test positive will need to stay out of school for 5 days from onset of symptoms and then wear a mask for an additional 5 days upon return to school, per the CDC guidelines.
- 4) At designated times, all students must wipe down the area (equipment, surfaces, tools, etc.) that they were working in with disinfectant supplied by the school.

Anyone not abiding by these policies and procedures will be subject to disciplinary action, which may include termination from the program. These policies and procedures are for your own health and safety and should not be taken lightly.
